My 1926 Dodge Brothers is a one family car. My Grandfather bought it new. After he quit driving, it stayed in the garage. When I got to driving age, being the oldest grandson, he wanted to give it to me. My Grandmother and Uncle talked him out of it. Thank God they did, because at that age I didn't have two brain cells to rub together, and I would have trashed it.

Fast forward many years and it moved to several family garages and barns. I tried to buy it from my Aunt in 1986. Her answer, "No. I'm giving it to you."

I didn't want to make it into a hot rod. Been there – done that. I decided on a nice cruiser.
