Pete Larsen's 1970 Firebird 400**



Pete bought this car in 1985 from the original owner. It is Pete's first car. It came with the original 4.1 liter straight six motor. He drove it as original for about four years but always knew he would put a Pontiac 400 motor in it and turn it into a performance car.

It now sports a Pontiac 400, Turbo 350, and a beefier GM 8.5 inch 10 Bolt with posi-traction and 3.42 gearing.

There are more changes planned to upgrade the motor and transmission for better performance. The car currently runs 13.4/103 mph in the 1/4 at Woodburn.






