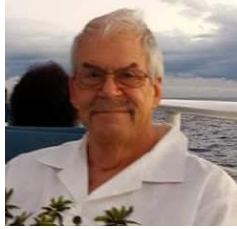
Rollin' Oldies Wiseguy Corner

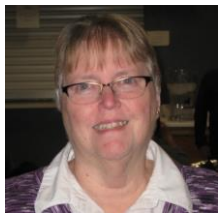

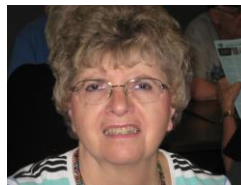
