### **Rollin' Oldies January Car of the Month Kitty and Neal Hubbard's 1966 Ford Mustang**



We purchased the Mustang on July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020 which was listed on Northwest Classic Auto Mall. It was located in Junction City, so I called the owner, then drove down to look it over. It has a 289 Hi-Po V8 with Edelbrock intake, Holley carb, solid lifters, and Hedman headers. It needed new brakes, so we added discs on the front and new drums on the back. Then we added a Wilwood master cylinder plus all new wheel cylinders. We pulled the old brake lines out and installed stainless steel brake lines.

While doing the brakes we saw that the front end was almost all original and needing new parts. So we ordered and installed them until it was almost entirely new again. We added new shocks at all four corners.

After owning my '66 Ford truck, which had a lot more power, I still enjoy driving the Mustang more. I drove it home this summer from Waldport on old highway 34. Driving it around all those corners made me really appreciate its sports-car feel!

I am looking forward to showing it at car shows this year, starting with the Winter Rod and Speed Show at the Fair Grounds
