Last August, a friend and I, went to see the land speed record racing at Bonneville. The Salt Flats are a very impressive, harsh environment. It is at 5000 feet elevation, with glaring sun from the sky and it's reflection from the salt. The hardcore racers often spend hours in the staging lines for the chance to break a world record.

The two main courses are ten miles long, with one shorter course for lower-speed classes and driver certification. The rules provide for many body styles and drivetrains, creating over 200 classes.



With no obstructions on the courses and the reflection of sound from the salt, the engines can be heard miles down the course. My personal favorites were the sounds of the big-block engines running on nitro.

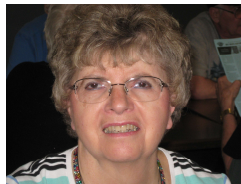
