Lynn & I bought our 1932 Ford Roaster back in 2006 at a used car lot in Northern Washington. The next summer we went to Florence, Oregon for our first car show, and won a Trophy. We were hooked on doing more shows.



Fast forward to 2010, the car & Mullins trailer were stolen and then recovered a week later. There was enough damage that it had to be repainted, so Lynn chose the color that it is today.





We know the car was put together sometime after 1985. Other than regular maintenance, the car has run fine since then. The engine

and transmission are from a 1974 Corvette. The frame is stock and the brake system is early Mustang.

We have a new project trailer that we got last year and expect to have it out soon. It is a 1935 KOZY KAMP Tent Trailer. The company was in Portland and only made the trailers for a few years. We knew the owner who had it in his private museum the past 15 years.
