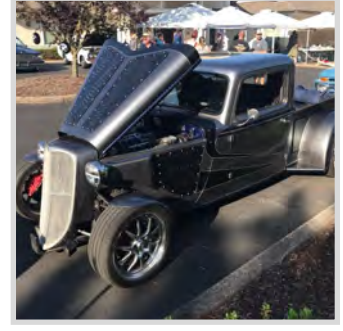
- 6.2 Liter LS Chevrolet Engine

- air conditioning, electric windows, back-up camera, custom front bumper, custom hitch,. Not to mention it is John's Daily Driver!

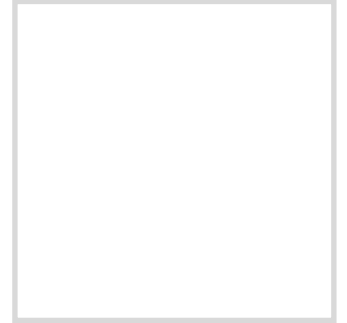
If you have not had the pleasure of meeting John, he will be glad to have you introduce yourself at the next Club meeting, or event.

Amendment Proposal

Rollin' Oldies Car Club of Lebanon

By-Laws

Currently reads:

Article IV – *Duties of Officers*

Section 6 – Cruise Master

The Cruise Master will be directly responsible for all tours of the Club, whether chaired by the Cruise Master or delegated. They shall maintain observance of all traffic laws of the state, county, or city where such tours take place. The Cruise Master has the authority to confirm insurance coverage at any time deemed necessary. They shall also police the spacing of Club cars on the roads so that other traffic has sufficient room to pass as needed. Before each tour begins to move, they shall assemble all drivers to outline the route and destination to be taken so that no one becomes lost. They shall also adjust the speed on tours to ensure that the slower vehicles are not damaged by being overdriven.

Revised to read:

Section 6 – Cruise Master

The Cruise Master will be directly responsible for all tours of the Club, whether chaired by the Cruise Master or delegated. They shall maintain observance of all traffic laws of the state, county, or city where such tours take place. The Cruise Master has the authority to confirm insurance coverage at any time deemed necessary. They shall also police the spacing of Club cars on the roads so that other traffic has sufficient room to pass as needed. Before each tour begins to move, they shall assemble all drivers to outline the route and destination to be taken so that no one becomes lost. They shall also adjust the speed on tours to ensure that the slower vehicles are not damaged by being overdriven. **The Cruise Master shall provide, each month, current information on regional car shows and auto related events to the members at the meetings and provide a print ready copy to the Newsletter Editor for publication to all members. The Cruise Master shall also provide emails to members on later upcoming events that are not included in the Cruise Master's monthly member meeting report.**
